



Our demographic consists primarily of young people and young adults aged 18-34.

We have noticed that our male audience consistently outnumbers our female audience across all age groups.

Despite the fact that the majority of our audience is male, it is to note that out of the 350 link clicks, the majority were from female Instagram users, primarily within the age group of 25-34. Following this group, we saw the 35-44 and 45-54 age groups also engage with our content.

Our Facebook audience shares a common trait with our Instagram audience: a higher proportion of male users than female. However, we have observed that our Facebook audience tends to be more senior compared to our Instagram audience. In fact, the number of users aged 45-65+ on Facebook is significantly higher than on Instagram.

KE outcomes and impact

The overall project has impacted more than 800 individuals. The ULL website was soft-launched in May 2023, offering interdisciplinary educational content for Hong Kong primary and secondary school students and the public. It features animations, interviews, guizzes, hands-on activities videos, and 360-degree virtual gallery views, receiving positive feedback and 2,782 unique page views within two months. ULL's interdisciplinary approach has successfully engaged students in various subjects. School group bookings have surged over the past two months, and students have improved their language skills and understanding of museum roles. Their knowledge of artworks has been enriched through the diverse activities provided, while the dictionary section has offered additional resources to reinforce understanding. In terms of interdisciplinary learning, all modules have been designed with this goal in mind. Besides visual arts, individuals learn about Chinese history, general studies, sciences, and geography. Although some modules may have a more pronounced multidisciplinary presence, feedback indicates that everyone has encountered at least two subject areas in their learning experiences. Feedback from 379 school surveys and 75 public surveys has been collected, and the project continues to develop content and usability. Users have expressed interest in a bilingual version of the website, more video content, and interactive games. While the team is considering using the Metaverse for guided exhibition tours and docent training, the project plans to enhance offerings and draw more physical visitors by strengthening the online-offline connection between the virtual world and the museum.

藝學堂網站於2023年5月上線,旨在為香港中小學生及大眾提供跨學科的教育資源。網站內容包含動畫影片、訪問、知識問答、手工製作活動和虛擬展廳等教材。自上線以來,此項目已收集了379份學校和75份公眾調查意見,獲得大多數的正面回饋、並累計2,782次獨立訪問頁面瀏覽,惠及超過800人。

藝學堂的跨學科教育模式讓學生有機會接觸不同學科知識。過去兩個月,學校團體的預約大幅增加,學生的語言能力和對博物館角色的理解也有所提升。本項目活動加深了學生對藝術作品的認識,而「詞典」部分則提供額外資源,幫助理解文字及概念。所有單元都是根據跨學科理念為目標而設計。

除了視覺藝術,用戶還能學習到有關中國歷史、常識、科學和地理等學科知識。儘管部分單元具有更明顯的跨學科內容,每位用戶在學習過程中至少能接觸到兩個學科。為加強虛擬世界與博物館之間的線上和線下聯繫,本團隊將繼續開發內容、增設中英雙語頁面提高網站的易用性、製作更多影片和互動遊戲,並透過元宇宙進行展覽導賞和導賞員訓練。
